RAINFALL AND TEMPERATURES

RAINFALL





Figure 1: Rainfall distribution as first dekad of November 2018

Some thunderstorms were observed in most parts of the country during the reporting period, resulting in improved rainfall throughout the country (**Figure 1**) and (**Map1**).

The Lowveld and Lubombo Plateau recorded amounts above that of their longterm mean, while the Highveld and Middleveld remained with below average observations (**Table 1**).

TEMPERATURES




Figure 2: Minimum temperature as first dekad of November 2018




Figure 3: Maximum temperature as first dekad of November 2018

Below average temperatures were observed during the dekad, ranging between 12°C to 27°C (**Figure 2**) and (**Figure 3**).

MAIZE AND OTHER CROPS

MAIZE CROP STAGE AND CONDITION

Very few maize observed to have germinated in some parts of the Highveld. Otherwise most is still being planted.

OTHER CROPS

No other crops have been planted.

CURRENT FARMING ACTIVITY

Most farmers have commenced with land preparation and planting (**Picture 1**). Most activities were conducted during the dekad as much rainfall was received.

WATER SITUATION

Water levels in major dams in the country are at satisfactory levels mostly above 60% and rivers have adequate flows.

MEDIUM-TERM OUTLOOK

RAINFALL

Not much rainfall is anticipated save for some precipitation on the 21st of November 2018 and toward the end of the outlook period in some parts. Otherwise it will be mostly dry.

TEMPERATURE

Warm to hot temperatures are expected in the outlook period.

SOIL MOISTURE

Not much improvement in soil moisture anticipated in the outlook period.

WIND SPEED


Wind will be light to moderate breeze speeds in the outlook period.

LIVESTOCK AND PASTURES

Livestock continues to be doing well in most parts of the country as vegetation continues to improve in most parts.
