



Figure 1: Rainfall distribution as 3<sup>rd</sup> dekad of October 2018

Much reduced rainfall was observed during the third dekad of October 2018 (**Figure 1**).




Figure 2: Minimum temperature as 3<sup>rd</sup> dekad of October 2018




Figure 3: Maximum temperature as 3<sup>rd</sup> dekad of October 2018

Temperatures were mostly below average, ranging between 9°C and 27°C as observed by the reporting stations (**Figure 2**) and (**Figure 3**).

### MAIZE CROP STAGE AND CONDITION


Some farmers have planted maize, mainly in the Highveld.

Livestock is in good condition as vegetation remains at satisfactory condition (**Image 1**) and (**Image 2**).

## WATER SITUATION

Water levels have not shown any major improvement, however most water sources have adequate flows.

## **MEDIUM-TERM OUTLOOK**

### RAINFALL

Not much rainfall is expected save for light precipitation on the 6<sup>th</sup> and 7<sup>th</sup> of October 2018. Otherwise the rest of the outlook period will remain dry.

### TEMPERATURE

Temperatures will mostly be warm but hot in the Lowveld in the outlook period.

### SOIL MOISTURE

No improvement in soil moisture anticipated in the outlook period.

### WIND SPEED

Wind will be light to moderate breeze speeds ranging between 2-4m/s in the outlook period.




Image 1: Vegetation Condition Index image (3<sup>rd</sup> Dekad October 2018) *Source: FAO-GIEWS*
